Recognizing that race and other cultural identifying categories continue to impact individuals and communities in both enhancing and damaging ways, this continuing education event will be an introductory exploration of how race and culture operate on personal, interpersonal, group (organizational), and societal levels. With information and interactive exercises, participants will gain new perspective and tools for deepening their engagement at each level and will be guided to develop a leadership learning or application plan toward constructive and God-honoring interactions across human and cultural differences. Marie Onwubuariri has served for over ten years as a cross-cultural competency trainer in faith-based, educational, and professional settings. Her relational and contextual approach is shaped by a lifetime of continual formation at the intersection of cultures, her expansive and integrated experiences in local church, denominational, ecumenical, residential community, and secular settings, along with her formal education, which includes a BS in Management, a Master of Divinity with an emphasis in multicultural ministries, and a Doctor of Ministry in Transformation Leadership, which culminated in her dissertation topic, "Cultural Self-knowing and Negotiation: A Spiritual Practice for Intercultural Leaders." Marie is co-editor and chapter author of *Trouble the Water: A Christian Resource for the Work of Racial Justice* (Nurturing Faith, 2017). Marie currently serves as the Executive Minister of the American Baptist Churches of Wisconsin.
